Supporting Every Student's Next Step

We have an outstanding record of placing students into further or higher education once they leave Claremont. We work in partnership with Prospects (part of The Shaw Trust) to ensure that no student is NEET (Not in Education, Employment or Training) after Year 11 or Year 13.

We take great care to ensure that all students can access this valuable guidance when they need it most — particularly in Years 11 and 13, when key decisions about next steps are made. This focus on the individual student, and on identifying the pathway that is right for them, supports effective transitions into:

- Our own outstanding Sixth Form, or an alternative pathway at 16+
- University, or an alternative pathway at 18+

Our Careers Library — Unifrog

We have moved away from a traditional, prospectus-filled careers library to the online platform Unifrog. This gives students in Years 11, 12 and 13 everything they need in one place to research universities, courses, training and apprenticeships, and career opportunities. Unifrog is linked to the UCAS website, so information is always kept up to date, and parents also have their own Unifrog login so they can support their son or daughter.
