Dear Parents/Carers and Partners,

It gives me great pleasure to write to inform you that following our Ofsted inspection on 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> May 2015, Claremont achieved an Outstanding grade again. *"Claremont is an Outstanding school which has maintained consistently impressive levels of achievement over time." Ofsted 2015.* The Inspection team judged the school to be Outstanding in all categories which include; Leadership and Management, Behaviour and Safety of pupils, Quality of Teaching, Achievement of pupils and the Sixth Form provision.

We are very proud to be the first secondary school in Brent to achieve an Ofsted Outstanding grading under the new framework in <u>all</u> categories and the first secondary school to achieve two consecutive outstanding grades. This is a coveted designation that not only reflects the commitment and hard work of all key stakeholders but also reaffirms Claremont's position as a lead school on both a local and national scale. It comes as no surprise that 97% of our parents would recommend Claremont to other parents.

Our unwavering commitment to the well being of our students was highly commended and all students who spoke to the inspection team reported that they felt very safe in all parts of the school. Our students "demonstrate and affirm great pride in their school and all groups of students are remarkably positive about their learning at Claremont". Students appreciate the high expectations that staff have of them and also the support that is given to them as required. The inspection team rightly noted that "relationships between staff and students are extremely purposeful and make a marked contribution to students' high levels of achievement".

The team were also exceptionally complimentary about the work our staff do with our students and the positive relationships between them that foster the high expectations and confidence that lead to outstanding progress for our students.

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The team also noted that our teachers *"routinely plan work which motivates and engages students effectively, where the work is pitched to match the needs and interests of students of all abilities*". Alongside this, our students display their typical mature and respectful behaviour around school – a testament to the hard work and shared vision we all have for our school. *"Students conduct themselves around the large school site with maturity and respect for others."* Ofsted 2015

Aditionally, the inspectors recognised the relentless drive, shared vision and passion that leaders at all levels share, which drives the school to make exceptional progress for all of its students. The team was notably impressed with all areas of teaching and achievement, especially in Maths - *"mathematics teaching at Claremont is extremely accomplished"* and English - *"the teaching in English is consistently strong "* for all of our students. It is the *"excellent leadership that has ensured all groups of students achieve to a similarly high standard." Ofsted 2015* 

In addition to this, the team recognised the contribution that is made from learning beyond the classroom. They spoke highly of the social, moral, spiritual and cultural development of our students where British values underpin the ethos at Claremont. A crucial element of this are the shared vision and values we have and promote at Claremont, Respect, Enjoyment, Perseverance, Excellence and Aspiration, all of which were clearly seen throughout the school by the inspection team over the course of the two days. Looking ahead, we are confident that we will achieve an outstanding set of results for our students this summer and look forward to continuing our work with you all to ensure your child has a successful transition into their secondary education.
